Save Energy

- + ENERGY STAR qualified lighting products use two-thirds less energy than standard incandescent lighting, while providing more light.

- + If every household in the United States changed their 5 highest-use light fixtures (or the light bulbs in them) to ENERGY STAR,
 - We would save more than 800 billion kWh of energy and keep one trillion pounds of greenhouse gases out of the air;
 - Our annual energy savings alone would be equivalent to the annual output of more than 21 power plants;
 - Our annual energy savings could light more than 34 million US homes for one year.

Save Money

- + Did you know that the average home has approximately 30 light fixtures? By replacing the five most frequently used light fixtures in your home, or the light bulbs in them, with ENERGY STAR qualified lighting, you can save more than \$60 each year in energy costs.

- + ENERGY STAR qualified light bulbs and fixtures save money because they operate more efficiently, thus reducing your electricity bill.

Save Time

- + The pin-based light bulbs in ENERGY STAR qualified fixtures need to be changed, on average, once every 7 years. This means less time changing light bulbs, a convenience especially in hard to reach areas.

Help Protect the Environment

- + Products that earn the ENERGY STAR prevent greenhouse gas emissions by meeting strict energy efficiency guidelines set by the US Environmental Protection Agency and the Department of Energy. That means less energy is generated by power plants, decreasing the amount of fossil fuels burned, which results in less air pollution.
